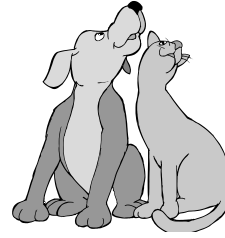

The Somerset Regional Animal Shelter (SRAS) is a not-for-profit municipal organization that provides animal control services and cares for approximately 1,500 lost, abandoned and surrendered animals each year. Friends of Somerset Regional Animal Shelter (FOSRAS) is a 501(c)(3) volunteer group established to support SRAS. We are proud to say that all animals that are adopted from SRAS will go home spayed/neutered. We are working towards helping to control the pet over-population problem.



FOSRAS works as a team with the SRAS staff to organize on-site and off-site adoptions, fundraising events, volunteers, learning opportunities and so much more! FOSRAS meets monthly at the Bridgewater Public Library, located at North Bridge Street and Vogt Drive, at 7 p.m. (meeting dates are listed on our website). Please join us. All are welcome!

OUR MISSION

The purpose of FOSRAS is to promote humane care and treatment of all animals provided protection by the Somerset Regional Animal Shelter and to promote the return of lost animals to their owners, the finding of suitable homes for animals without guardians, humane treatment for all animals of all types, the education of the public in animal welfare, and spay/neuter programs as a method of animal population control.

DONATIONS

Your tax deductible donation to FOSRAS goes directly to helping the animals. There are no paid positions within FOSRAS. Your donation will be applied to our Cupid Fund or towards general medical expenses, new equipment, shelter improvements, off-site adoptions and to cover expenses for any “special needs” pets that are currently living at the shelter. ADOPTIONS

To adopt a new companion, you must be at least 18 years of age, fill out an adoption profile application, and provide proof of home ownership or a lease copy stating that you are allowed to have pets in your rental home. Veterinary references are also required.



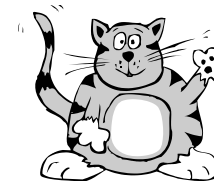
ADOPTION FEES:

DOGS UP TO 1 YEAR \$350
DOGS OVER 1 YEAR \$300

Includes: general vet exam, spay/neuter, heartworm testing, deworming, microchip, martingale collar, Distemper vaccine, Bordatella (kennel cough) vaccine, and rabies vaccinations (puppies will not be vaccinated for rabies if they are under 4 months old).



KITTENS UNDER 1 YEAR \$175
CATS \$125



Includes general vet exam, spay/neuter, feline leukemia/FIV screening, deworming, microchip, rabies & distemper vaccinations (kittens will not be vaccinated for rabies if they are under 4 months old).

Adoption fees cover the cost of the medical expenses that are incurred by our guests!
